## CONTRACT FOR FACILITATION MODULE

**LEVEL: MASTERS (20 POINTS)**

The aim of this module is to provide you with the opportunity to use your practice of facilitation skills as the source of analysis, reflection, research and action-taking. You will use the opportunity for facilitation to set a contract of activities to be undertaken, complete the activities and reflect on the results achieved.

### **The following outcomes are expected:**

#### **To understand, critically analyse, evaluate and explain**

- the value of facilitation at work
- the relationship between theory and practice in facilitation
- the effects of taking action to enhance effectiveness as a facilitator

#### **To be able to**

- reflexively analyse facilitation opportunities and requirements at work
  - establish a contract of activities for researching, action-taking and learning about facilitation
  - demonstrate a critical awareness of facilitation ideas, approaches and outcomes achieved
  - synthesise data gathered and evaluate outcomes against criteria set .
  - present findings in an appropriate format appropriately referenced

- ◆ You will establish an initial **Contract for Action** of your aims, objectives, activities and assessment criteria with a tutor.
  - ◆ As you complete activities, you will **reflectively and reflexively analyse** your practice by keeping written logs.
  - ◆ You will pose follow-up questions from your activities for further reading and understanding
  - ◆ You will present your findings as a report for assessment, the indicative word length of the report is **4,500 words** (+/- 5%).
