## yournextbus

'YourNextBus' provides the scheduled or predicted time of a bus at a requested stop. Text 63876 ('METRO') with the eight digit bus stop number (you'll find this on the bus stop flag/timetable display and on the enclosed map). You'll be sent a response text message containing information for up to the next four services from that bus stop. It's also possible to receive times via WAP or the internet.

Text Costs: Outbound texts are charged at your standard rate. Returned texts are charged at a maximum of 12p.

## Day Fares

Bus operators offer day fares that can be used on any of their services in Leeds. These are currently £1.50 on Geldard services (including 28B and 92A), £2.00 on Centrebus services (including 92) and £4.30 (£3.80 off-peak) on First services. You can also buy a MetroDay ticket for £5.00 which can be used on any bus service in West Yorkshire whoever the operator is.

## Discounted Travel Passes

**Student Plus MetroCard** – The moneysaving Student Plus MetroCard means you pay just once a week or once a month and enjoy virtually unlimited bus and train transport throughout West Yorkshire. They're available from Freshers Fair, Metro Travel Centres, Metro bus stations, staffed rail stations and Post Offices and cost £17.00 a week or £62.50 a month.

Bus and train companies, such as First, and Northern Rail, offer reduced rates to students if you buy a photocard and tickets in advance.

**Staff MetroCard** – Staff can receive a 15% discount on annual Metrocards. These passes give unlimited travel on all buses in West Yorkshire and on trains in the purchased rail zone. The annual cost can be paid back monthly via payroll.

**Staff Firstbus** – For staff who only travel by First buses in West Yorkshire Leeds Met purchases First Bus Cards on behalf of its colleagues at a discount and then colleagues can pay back the discounted cost of the card over a 10 month period.

**Staff Northern Rail Annual Pass** – Staff can get 12 weeks travel on Northern rail services for free and can pay for this annual pass over 12 months.

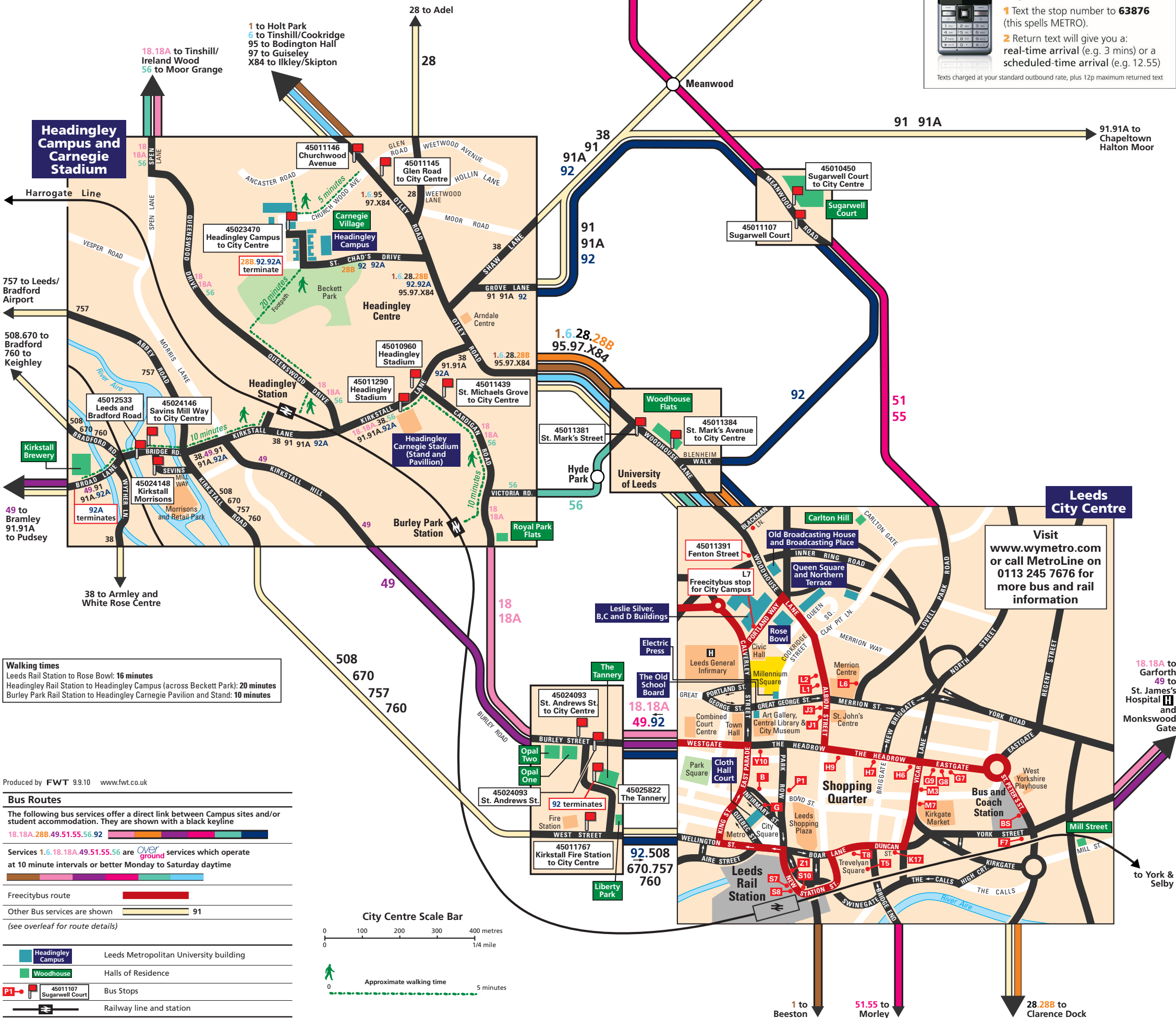


**When's the next? Just text!**

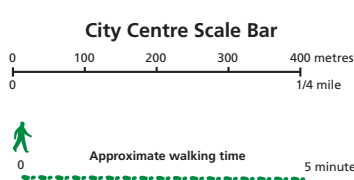
- 1 Text the stop number to **63876** (this spells METRO).
