Leeds Met is well connected. It has excellent public transport, cycling and walking facilities. Our Civic Quarter sites are all within easy walking distance of Leeds City Rail Station. Headingley Campus has a bus stop on campus and is 3 miles out of the city centre on one of the main bus routes. Frequent bus services connect all our halls of residences and popular student areas to our Civic Quarter and Headingley Campuses.

The free city bus runs every few minutes from 6.30am to 7.30pm Monday to Saturday, and links Leeds' rail and bus stations with our Civic Quarter campus (Portland Way Bus Stop).

£1 All Day on the 28B

Pay a £1 fare and travel as many times as you like in that day on the 28B which runs from Clarence Dock, through the city centre, past Civic Quarter sites, onto Headingley Campus.

yournextbus

'YourNextBus' provides the scheduled or predicted time of a bus at a requested stop. Text 63876 ('METRO') with the eight digit bus stop number (you'll find this on the bus stop flag/timetable display). You'll be sent a response text message containing information for up to the next four services from that bus stop. It's also possible to receive times via WAP or the internet.

Text Costs: Outbound texts are charged at your standard rate. Returned texts are charged at a maximum of 12p.

Discounted Travel Passes

Student Plus MetroCard - The moneysaving Student Plus MetroCard means you pay just once a week or once a month and enjoy virtually unlimited bus and train transport throughout West Yorkshire. They're Available from Metro Travel Centres, bus stations and Post Offices and cost £17.00 a week or £62.50 a month.

Bus and train companies, such as First, Transpennine Express and GNER, offer reduced rates to students if you buy a photocard and tickets in advance.

Staff MetroCard - Staff can receive a 15% discount on annual Metrocards. These passes give unlimited travel on all buses in West Yorkshire and on trains in the purchased rail zone. The annual cost can be paid back monthly via payroll.

Staff Firstbus - For staff who only travel by First buses in West Yorkshire Leeds Met purchases First Bus Cards on behalf of its colleagues at a discount and then colleagues can pay back the discounted cost of the card over a 10 month period.

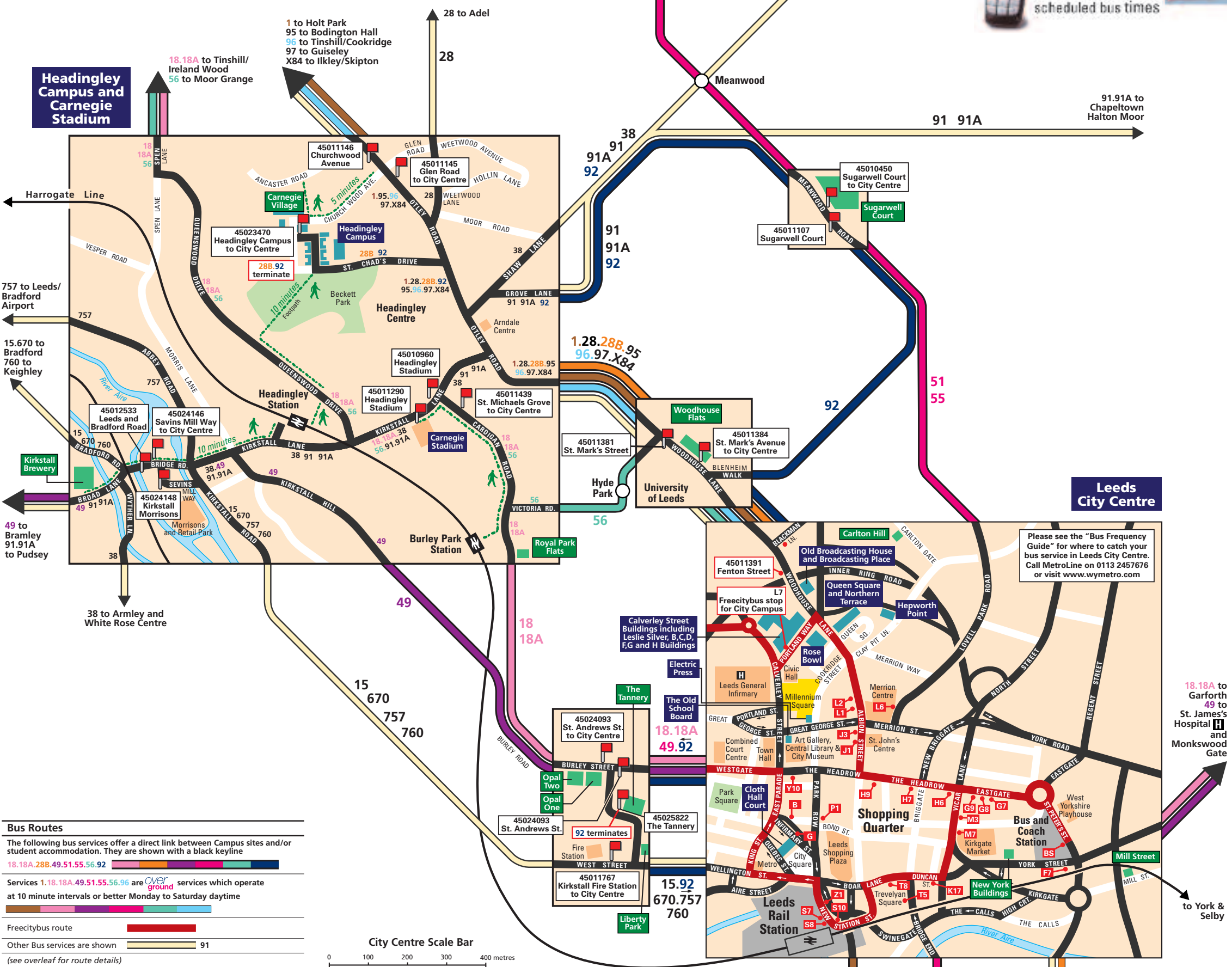
