Who is it for?

The Emergency Aid with Automated External Defibrillation qualification is a competency based course, designed to train individuals in both theoretical and practical aspects of First Aid when needing to use a defibrillator. Ideal for those involved in environments where an automated external defibrillator is available in an emergency.

Course Content

On completion of training, successful candidates should be able to:

- assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency;
- administer first aid to a casualty who has chest pains;
- administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious;
- administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation, including the use of pocket masks;
- Automated External Defibrillation – theory and principles
- Automated External Defibrillation – using training simulators

Course Exam

You must, in order to gain a certificate:

- attend all course hours

You will be continuously assessed on your skills throughout the duration of the course

Certificate:

An Emergency Aid with AED certificate, which is valid for one year, will be awarded to all successful candidates.
