The UKCC 2 Coach Award is designed for adults (at least 16 years of age, but cannot gain certification until 18 years of age) and provides candidates with an opportunity to study and be assessed on both the practical and theoretical aspects of coaching cricket to groups of adults and children in an appropriate environment. If your experience of coaching cricket is limited, you are advised to attend the Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Cricket Course before applying for the Level 2.

Course Aims

The course will help coaches develop their understanding of:

- Coaching principles and ethics in cricket
- How to plan cricket coaching sessions
- How to deliver and evaluate safe and effective cricket coaching sessions

Course Content

The programme consists of 8 modules and a final assessment and is outlined below:

- Introducing and developing the game of cricket to people of all ages
- Developing and improving players particularly at FUNDAMENTAL and stages of the LTAD model
- Developing your coaching skills, knowledge and qualities
- Demonstrating competence against UKCC2 national standards for coaches

Course Exam/Certificate

To fulfil the course requirements, candidates must:

- Complete the assignments set following Modules 1-8
- Complete the home study packs and associated assessments
- Complete the support practice module (minimum of 10 sessions of at least 30 minutes)
- Submit your record of coaching and assignments prior to your assessment day
- Attend an assessment day where you will be asked to coach a group of players
- Demonstrate all the competencies required for an ECB Coach Award (UKCC2)
