Who is it for?/Course Pre-requisites

Candidates must:

- Have an active interest and involvement in tennis.
- Hold the 1st4sport Level 1 Coaching Assistant Qualification or the LTA Tennis Assistants/ECA/ETTC.
- Be registered with the LTA or have a current, satisfactory Criminal Records Bureau Enhanced Disclosure obtained through the LTA (see below) and hold a current HSE approved First Aid certificate.

CRIMINAL RECORDS BUREAU (CRB) ENHANCED DISCLOSURE

Candidates should obtain a CRB application form by emailing their name and address to crb@LTA.org.uk Alternatively you may contact your LTA county office.

Please note: The Disclosure must be processed through the LTA and be less than 12 months old at the start of the course. Unfortunately, the LTA are unable to accept a Disclosure completed by another organisation, regardless of issue date.

Course Aims/Content

This course aims to build on skills learnt on the Level 1 course and will expand your knowledge of working with groups of players in different environments. It will focus on running short format competitions that will allow beginners to enjoy competing. If you want to help within a coaching programme and would like to be able to deliver group coaching to beginners of any age then this qualification is for you.



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Course Structure

The qualification is divided into the following units:

- Coaching Principles and Ethics
- Plan Coaching Sessions
- Conduct Coaching Sessions
- Review Coaching Sessions
- Coaching Tennis
- 4 hours coaching experience between day 2 and 3 of the course
- 4 hours coaching experience between day 4 and 5 of the course

The course is five days - 2 consecutive days followed by a 4 - 6 week break for mentored experience, a further 2 consecutive days followed by a 4 - 6 week break for mentored experience and then a final 1 day assessment.

Candidates are required to have their coaching assistant experience organised before the course starts. For help with this please contact your course provider or your LTA county office - contact details can be found at www.LTA.org.uk/in-your-area

Course Exam/Certificate

The course is assessed in two areas:

- On court practical coaching assessment using course materials
- Portfolio of evidence

Candidates must attend all the sessions on the course at the same venue and pass all elements of assessment to be successful
